Nature Restoration Project in the Districts of Tamura, Okijuku and Tozaki in the Kasumigaura Region




Aims of Project

With the overall goal of "conserving and restoring the lakeshore zone that forms a point of contact between human habitation and the lake so that it can nurture and sustain a diversity of flora and fauna", project is underway aiming to preserve and restore biodiversity and the landscape as well as to restore the connection between people and the lake.

The area the project is being carried out in is divided into nine sections from A to I.






In Sections G to I, the lakeshore vegetation zone extends from the lakeshore levee out to distances between 20m and 80m offshore.

Work Undertaken in Section I

With the aim of creating an area of shallow and calm water featuring a complex shoreline and recreating a habitat to sustain a diversity of creatures, works underway include the creation of a jetty and a wave dissipating revetment. It is hoped that this section will be used as a venue for environmental learning.
