

“Mt. Nyoho” An unknown collapse

■ An invisible large collapsing site
Mt. Nyoho was originally a conical stratovolcano with a wide base like Mt. Nantai. However, its summit was blown off during its last tremendous eruption 86,000 years ago, forming a large pit known as a caldera. The caldera eroded over many years following that, forming a large collapsing site. These are the "*Ojika Otoshi*" and "*Nanatakizawa Collapsing Site*."
