## "Jyoryu Sabo Dam No. 10" Effective for trapping debris floods

■ Prevention of damage from a second disaster

One of the sabo dams constructed with the aim of controlling debris floods from the Inari River, located upstream of the Sabo Dam No. 10, a Registered Tangible Cultural Property and a Civil Engineering Heritage Site. It trapped debris floods and driftwood during Typhoon No. 12 in August-September 2011 and Typhoon No. 18 in September 2015, and

protected the downstream area against damage.
