Nikko City Autumn Tourism Exhibition 2024

Nikko City, home to Nikko Toshogu Shrine, a World Heritage Site dedicated to Tokugawa Iyasu, the first shogun of the Edo Shogunate, is a sister city with Taito Ward, where Asakusa is located. Nikko City is a sister city of Taito City, where Asakusa is located, because the city prospered as a gate town when Sensoji Temple was designated as a place of prayer by the Shogunate.

This year also marks the 25th anniversary of the listing of the Shrines and Temples of Nikko as a UNESCO World Heritage Site and the 90th anniversary of Nikko National Park's designation as a national park.

Here we introduce Nikko's attractions, including its many architectural sites, its surrounding natural environment and cultural landscape, and Nikko-bori origins in the construction of the Toshogu Shrine, with a focus on visitor attractions that can be enjoyed in the coming autumn and winter.

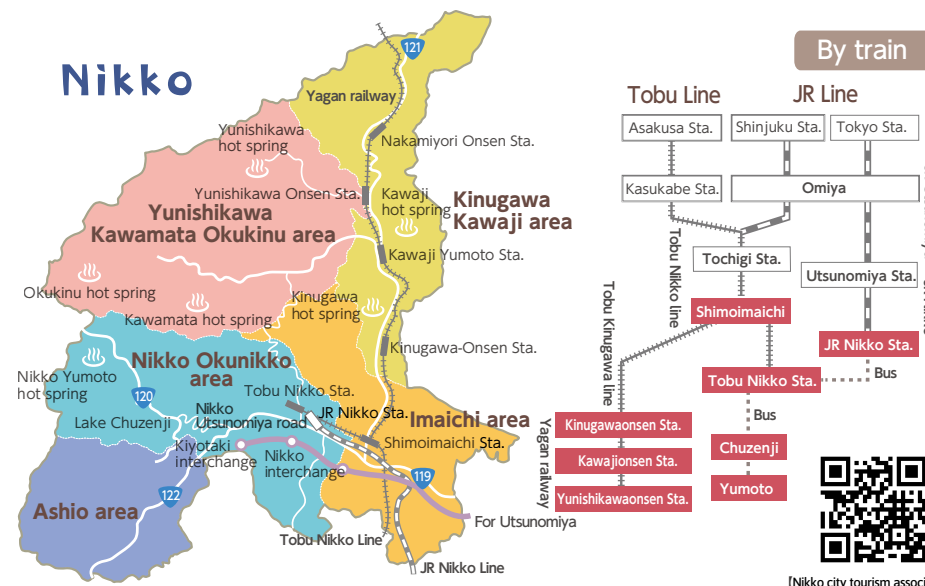
